A bill to be entitled

An act relating to complaint review boards for law enforcement officers and correctional officers; amending s. 112.532, F.S.; extending the right to a complaint review board to sheriffs and deputy sheriffs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 112.532, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

- 112.532 Law enforcement officers' and correctional officers' rights.—All law enforcement officers and correctional officers employed by or appointed to a law enforcement agency or a correctional agency shall have the following rights and privileges:
- shall be composed of three members: One member selected by the chief administrator of the agency or unit; one member selected by the aggrieved officer; and a third member to be selected by the other two members. Agencies or units having more than 100 law enforcement officers or correctional officers shall use utilize a five-member board, with two members being selected by the administrator, two members being selected by the aggrieved officer, and the fifth member being selected by the other four members. The board members shall be law enforcement officers or correctional officers selected from any state, county, or municipal agency within the county. There shall be a board for law enforcement officers and a board for correctional officers

30 whose members shall be from the same discipline as the aggrieved officer. The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to 31 32 sheriffs or deputy sheriffs.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
