15 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

17 Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section

30 (1) SCHEDULE I.--A substance in Schedule I has a high  
31 potential for abuse and has no currently accepted medical use in
