into an agreement, no later than October 1, 2008, with the Florida Association of Centers for Independent Living to administer the James Patrick Memorial Work Incentive Personal Attendant Services, in conjunction with the Brain and Spinal Cord Injury Program in the Department of Health, shall develop a Program to provide personal care attendants to persons who have severe and chronic disabilities of all kinds and who are eligible under pursuant to subsection (1). Effective July 1, 2008, the Florida Association of Centers for Independent Living shall receive 12 percent of the funds paid to or on behalf of



participants from funds to be deposited with the Florida Endowment Foundation for Vocational Rehabilitation pursuant to ss. 320.08068(4)(d) and 413.4021(1) to administer the program. For the purpose of ensuring continuity of services, a memorandum of understanding shall be executed between the parties to cover the period between July 1, 2008, and the execution of the final agreement. association and the Department of Health shall jointly
