6 subsection (5), all claims for overpayment submitted to a
7 provider licensed under chapter 458, chapter 459, chapter 460,
8 chapter 461, or chapter 466 must be submitted to the provider
9 within 12 months after the health maintenance organization's
10 payment of the claim. A claim for overpayment shall not be
11 permitted beyond 12 months after the health maintenance
12 organization's payment of a claim, except that claims for
13 overpayment may be sought beyond that time from providers
14 convicted of fraud pursuant to s. 817.234.

15 (17) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
16 all claims for underpayment from a provider licensed under

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17 chapter 458, chapter 459, chapter 460, chapter 461, or chapter
18 466 must be submitted to the health maintenance organization
19 within 12 months after the health maintenance organization's
20 payment of the claim. A claim for underpayment shall not be
21 permitted beyond 12 months after the health maintenance
22 organization's payment of a claim.
