A bill to be entitled

An act relating to school funding; providing definitions; requiring the distribution of certain funds received by a school district to another school district when a student is enrolled in a school located outside of the school district where the student resides; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. <u>Distribution of school funds outside a student's</u> district of residence.—
  - (1) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Public K-12 school" has the same meaning as in s. 1000.04, Florida Statutes.
- (b) "Private school" has the same meaning as in s. 1002.01, Florida Statutes.
- (2) If a student who resides in one school district is enrolled in a public K-12 school that is located in another school district or is enrolled through the Corporate Income Tax Credit Scholarship Program, the Opportunity Scholarship Program, or the John M. McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program in a private school that is located in another school district, the school district where the student resides shall distribute any funds it receives for that student's education to the school district where the student is enrolled.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
