10 "bulletproof vest" means a bullet-resistant soft body armor  
11 providing, as a minimum standard, the level of protection known  
12 as "threat level I," which shall mean at least seven layers of  
13 bullet-resistant material providing protection from three shots  
14 of 158-grain lead ammunition fired from a .38 caliber handgun at  
15 a velocity of 850 feet per second.
