7 Section 3. Subsection (17) is added to section 420.5095,  
8 Florida Statutes, to read:

9 420.5095 Community Workforce Housing Innovation Pilot  
10 Program.--

11 (17) Funds that were appropriated by s. 33, chapter 2006-  
12 69, Laws of Florida, and that were declined or returned after  
13 being awarded shall be made available for workforce-housing  
14 projects as provided in this subsection.

15 (a) To be eligible for such funds, a project must be  
16 created to provide workforce housing for teachers and  
17 instructional personnel employed by the school district of the

18 county where the project is located and otherwise comply with  
19 this section. The corporation shall give an eligible project  
20 priority for funding if the project:

21 1. Is on land provided by a school district under s.  
22 1001.43;

23 2. Involves a public-private partnership that includes the  
24 school district and a national nonprofit organization created by  
25 Congress to provide financial support, technical assistance, and  
26 training for community-based revitalization efforts; and

27 3. Is located in a county where a project that had been  
28 previously selected for funding under this section did not go  
29 forward.

30 (b) The corporation shall select projects for funding under  
31 this subsection through a competitive request for proposals.
