17 (9)(a) The department shall implement a secure print-on-
18 demand electronic temporary tag registration, record retention,
19 and issue system required for use by every department-authorized
20 issuer of temporary tags by the end of the 2007-2008 fiscal year.
21 Such system shall enable the department to issue, on demand, a
22 temporary tag number in response to a request from the issuer by
23 way of a secure electronic exchange of data and enable the issuer
24 to print the temporary tag that has all required information. A
25 motor vehicle dealer licensed under this chapter may charge a fee
26 to comply with this subsection.

27 (b) To ensure the continuation of operations for issuers if
28 a system outage occurs, the department shall allow the limited
29 use of a backup manual issuance method during an outage which
30 requires recordkeeping of information as determined by the
31 department and requires the timely electronic reporting of this
32 information to the department.

33 (c) The department may adopt rules necessary to administer
34 this subsection. Such rules may include exemptions from the
35 requirements of this subsection as required to administer the
36 program, as well as exemptions for issuers who do not require a
37 dealer license under this chapter because of the type or size of
38 vehicle being sold.
