17 upon proof that the licensee has failed to comply with the
18 department's requirements. The department may adopt rules to

20 (9) The department shall implement a secure print-on-demand
21 electronic temporary tag registration, record retention, and
22 issue system for use by every department-authorized issuer of
23 temporary tags by the end of the 2007-08 fiscal year. This
24 system shall enable the department to issue, on demand, a
25 temporary tag number in response to a request from the issuer
26 via a secure electronic exchange of data and then enable the
27 issuer to print the temporary tag with all required information.
28 The department may adopt rules as necessary to implement this
29 program.

30 Section 2. Section 320.96, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

31 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
