24 Florida Building Code, as amended on May 22, 2007; and

27 new buildings by at least 50 percent as compared to the
28 performance achieved as a result of the implementation of the
29 energy-efficiency provisions contained in the 2004 edition of the
30 Florida Building Code, as amended on May 22, 2007.
