1013.375 New or renovated educational facilities; standards for energy efficiency and sustainability. -- Each new educational facility, and each renovation of an educational facility which costs more than \$100,000, must achieve, at minimum, a silverlevel certification in the rating system used by the United States Green Building Council's Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design or a two-globe rating in the Green Globe rating system used by the Green Building Initiative.
