Between lines 1357 and 1358, insert:

Section 33. (1) In order to prevent the exploitation of children, all licensees in occupations or positions licensed by the state for which the secretary at each licensing department, or licensing board, as appropriate, determines licensees are likely to enter a dwelling or other building in the course of their licensed activities where children might be located at the time of entry shall be checked against the list of registration information regarding sexual predators and sexual offenders maintained by the Department of Law Enforcement. If a licensee is registered as a sexual offender or a sexual predator, the licensee or his or her employer must provide actual notice to all of the occupants of each property the sexual offender or

predator may be entering that he or she is a registered sex offender or predator. If all of the occupants do not expressly approve the entry of the offender or predator into the property, no such entry shall be allowed.

(2) Any violation of this section shall be grounds for disciplinary action against the licensee up to and including revocation.

act; requiring occupational or professional licensees to be checked against a specified sexual offender and predator registry if the licensing entity determines that a licensee is likely to enter a dwelling or other building in the course of his or her licensed activities where children might be located at the time of entry; requires that if the licensee is registered as a sexual offender or predator, the licensee or employer must notify the occupants that the licensee is a registered sex offender or predator; requiring all occupants to approve of entry; providing for disciplinary action against licensees for violations; providing an effective date.
