In considering the 20 21 request, the court shall conduct an evidentiary hearing to 22 determine whether a change of circumstances has occurred which warrants a change in the court order prohibiting contact and 23 whether it is in the best interest of the victim that the court 24 25 order be modified or rescinded. 26 (2) Any offender who violates a court order issued under 27 this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. 28 29 (3) The punishment imposed under this section shall run consecutive to any former sentence imposed for a conviction for 30 any offense under s. 794.011 or s. 800.04 or any offense in s. 31 775.084(1)(b)1.a.-o. 32 33 Section 2.
