 6 criteria; requiring publication; providing an effective

 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

 11 Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 1008.331, Florida
 12 Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (6) and a new subsection
 13 (5) is added to that section to read:

14 1008.331 Supplemental educational services in Title I
 15 schools; school district, ~~and~~ provider, and department
 16 responsibilities.--

17 (5) RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.--

18 (a) The Department of Education shall annually evaluate
 19 and assign to each state-approved supplemental educational
 20 services provider a grade of A, B, C, D, or F using the
 21 following specific evaluation criteria:

22 1. The increase in student academic achievement determined
 23 by required pretests and required posttests.

24 2. The increase in student achievement on FCAT Reading and
 25 FCAT Mathematics.

26 3. The percentage of student completion of a program.

27 4. The financial standing of a provider with a school
 28 district which relates to, but is not limited to, the timely

29 submission of invoices to receive payment for services, the
30 timely payment for any expenses, and the accurate accounting of
31 all receipts and disbursements.

32 5. Parent satisfaction surveys.

33 6. School district satisfaction surveys.

34 7. Principal satisfaction surveys.

35 8. Department reviews.

36 (b) The department shall assign the grades at the end of
37 each school year and make the grades available to the public on
38 the department's Internet website prior to the beginning of the
39 following school year. Reports of such grading must be provided
40 to the supplemental educational services providers and the
41 respective school districts.

42 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
