 10 311.12, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

14 (b)1. The members of the Seaport Security Standards
 15 Advisory Council shall be appointed by the Governor and consist
 16 of the following:

- 17 a. Two seaport directors.
- 18 b. Two seaport security directors.
- 19 c. One designee from the Department of Law Enforcement.
- 20 d. One designee from the Office of Motor Carrier
 21 Compliance of the Department of Transportation.
- 22 e. One designee from the Attorney General's Office.
- 23 f. One designee from the Department of Agriculture and
 24 Consumer Services.
- 25 g. One designee from the Office of Tourism, Trade, and
 26 Economic Development.
- 27 h. One designee from the Office of Drug Control.
- 28 i. One designee who represents seaport tenants.

29 | j. One designee who represents seaport workers.

30 | 2. In addition to the members designated in subparagraph
31 | 1., the council may invite a representative of the United States
32 | Coast Guard to attend and participate in council meetings as an
33 | ex officio, nonvoting member of the council.
