8 (2) (a) The council shall be composed of seven members  
 9 appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture.

10 (b) Each of four members of the council must be an  
 11 ultimate equitable owner of a wrecker company who has been an  
 12 ultimate equitable owner of that company for at least 5 years  
 13 before his or her appointment; one member must be a wrecker  
 14 operator who is not an ultimate equitable owner of a wrecker  
 15 company and who has been a wrecker operator for at least 5 years

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16 before his or her appointment; and two members must be  
17 laypersons. Each member must be a resident of this state. This  
18 paragraph expires July 1, 2014.

19 (c) Effective July 1, 2014, each of four members of the  
20 council must be an ultimate equitable owner of a wrecker company  
21 registered under this chapter who has been an ultimate equitable  
22 owner of that company registered for at least 5 years before his  
23 or her appointment; one member must be a wrecker operator  
24 certified under this chapter who is not an ultimate equitable  
25 owner of a wrecker company and who has been a certified wrecker  
26 operator for at least 5 years before his or her appointment; and  
27 two members must be laypersons. Each member must be a resident  
28 of this state.

29 (3) The term of each member of the council is 4 years,  
30 except that, in order to establish staggered terms, two members  
31 who are owners of wrecker companies and one layperson shall be  
32 appointed initially for a 2-year term. Members may be  
33 reappointed for additional terms, but may not serve more than 8  
34 consecutive years. A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder  
35 of the unexpired term in the same manner as the original  
36 appointment.

37 (4) (a) From among its members, the council shall annually  
38 elect a chair, who shall preside over the meetings of the  
39 council, and a vice chair.

40 (b) In conducting its meetings, the council shall use  
41 accepted rules of procedure. The department must keep a complete  
42 record of each meeting showing the names of members present and  
43 the actions taken. These records and other documents regarding

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44 matters within the jurisdiction of the council must be kept on  
45 file with the department.
