6 1012.865, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

7 1012.865 Sick leave.--Each community college board of
8 trustees shall adopt rules whereby any full-time employee who is
9 unable to perform his or her duties at the community college on
10 account of personal sickness, accident disability, or extended
11 personal illness, or because of illness or death of the
12 employee's father, mother, brother, sister, husband, wife,
13 child, or other close relative or member of the employee's own
14 household, and who consequently has to be absent from work shall
15 be granted leave of absence for sickness by the president or by

16 the president's designated representative. The following
17 provisions shall govern sick leave:

18 (2) EXTENT OF LEAVE WITH COMPENSATION.--

19 (b) A community college board of trustees may establish
20 rules and prescribe procedures whereby a full-time employee may,
21 at the beginning date of employment in any year, be credited
22 with 12 days of sick leave with compensation in excess of the
23 number of days the employee has earned. Upon termination of
24 employment, the employee's final compensation shall be adjusted
25 in an amount necessary to ensure that sick leave with
26 compensation does not exceed the days of earned sick leave as
27 provided herein. Accumulated sick leave may be transferred from
28 a Florida community college to the Department of Education for
29 employment in the department subsequent to December 31, 1997.
30 However, not more than 104 hours of sick leave may be
31 transferred from the community college to the Department of
32 Education for each year of employment in the department.
