1001.03 Specific powers of State Board of Education.--

8 (3) ESTABLISH CRIMINAL OR DELINQUENT ACTS DISQUALIFYING A  
 9 PERSON FROM ACQUIRING OR RETAINING A FLORIDA TEACHING  
 10 CERTIFICATE.--The State Board of Education shall establish and  
 11 adopt by rule a list of criminal or delinquent acts that  
 12 disqualify a person from acquiring or retaining a Florida  
 13 Teaching Certificate when a court of competent jurisdiction has  
 14 entered a judgment of conviction or an adjudication of  
 15 delinquency. The board shall review the list annually and amend

16 the list as necessary. A criminal or delinquent act committed in  
17 another state or under federal law, the elements of which  
18 constitute a criminal or delinquent act in this state, shall be  
19 considered for purposes of disqualification as if the act was  
20 committed in this state. The list of criminal or delinquent acts  
21 must include, at minimum, offenses included in s. 435.04, crimes  
22 involving moral turpitude, and the following:

23 (a) Section 787.025, relating to luring or enticing a  
24 child.

25 (b) Section 794.05, relating to unlawful sexual activity  
26 with certain minors.

27 (c) Section 810.14, relating to voyeurism.

28 (d) Section 810.145, relating to video voyeurism.
