1001.03 Specific powers of State Board of Education.--

(3) ESTABLISH CRIMINAL OR DELINQUENT ACTS DISQUALIFYING A PERSON FROM ACQUIRING OR RETAINING A FLORIDA TEACHING CERTIFICATE. -- The State Board of Education shall establish and adopt by rule a list of criminal or delinquent acts that disqualify a person from acquiring or retaining a Florida Teaching Certificate when a court of competent jurisdiction has entered a judgment of conviction or an adjudication of delinquency. The board shall review the list annually and amend 16

the list as necessary. A criminal or delinquent act committed in another state or under federal law, the elements of which constitute a criminal or delinquent act in this state, shall be considered for purposes of disqualification as if the act was committed in this state. The list of criminal or delinquent acts must include, at minimum, offenses included in s. 435.04, crimes involving moral turpitude, and the following:

- (a) Section 787.025, relating to luring or enticing a child.
- (b) Section 794.05, relating to unlawful sexual activity with certain minors.
 - (c) Section 810.14, relating to voyeurism.
 - (d) Section 810.145, relating to video voyeurism.
