 2 following **amendment**:

Senate Amendment

Delete lines 687-718

and insert:

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 8 (b)1. The Department of Education shall report student
 9 assessment data pursuant to s. 1008.34(3)(b) that is reported to
 10 schools that receive a school grade pursuant to s. 1008.34 or
 11 student assessment data pursuant to s. 1008.341(3) that is
 12 reported to alternative schools that receive a school
 13 improvement rating pursuant to s. 1008.341 to each charter
 14 school that:

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15 a. Does not receive a school grade pursuant to s. 1008.34
16 or a school improvement rating pursuant to s. 1008.341; and

17 b. Serves at least ten students who are tested on the
18 statewide assessment test pursuant to s. 1008.22.

19 2. The charter school shall report the information in
20 subparagraph 1. to each parent of a student at the charter
21 school, the parent of a child on a waiting list for the charter
22 school, the district in which the charter school is located, and
23 the governing board of the charter school. This paragraph does
24 not abrogate the provisions of s. 1002.22, relating to student
25 records, and the requirements of 20 U.S.C. s. 1232g, the Family
26 Educational Rights and Privacy Act.

27 3.a. Pursuant to this paragraph, the Department of
28 Education shall compare the charter school student performance
29 data for each charter school in subparagraph 1. with the student
30 performance data in traditional public schools in the district
31 in which the charter school is located and other charter schools
32 in the state. For charter alternative charter schools, the
33 department shall compare the student performance data described
34 in this paragraph with all alternative schools in the state. The
35 comparative data shall be provided by the following grade
36 groupings:

37 (1) Grades 3 through 5;

38 (11) Grades 6 through 8; and

39 (111) Grades 9 through 11.
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
