7 Section 29. (1) School districts are encouraged to enter
8 into partnerships with local businesses for purposes of
9 mentorship opportunities, the development of employment options
10 and additional funding sources, and other mutual benefits.

11 (2) As a pilot program through June 30, 2011, the Palm
12 Beach County school district may recognize its business partners
13 by publicly displaying such business partners' names on school
14 district property in the unincorporated areas. "Project
15 Graduation" and athletic sponsorships are examples of appropriate
16 recognition. The district shall make every effort to display its
17 business partners' names in a manner that is consistent with the

18 county standards for uniformity in size, color, and placement of
 19 signs. If the provisions of this section are inconsistent with
 20 the county ordinances or regulations relating to signs in the
 21 unincorporated areas or inconsistent with chapter 125, chapter
 22 166, or chapter 479, Florida Statutes, the provisions of this
 23 section prevail.
