6 may accept a Transportation Security Administration's  
7 Transportation Worker Identification Credential card in lieu of  
8 the Uniform Port Access Credential Card required under this  
9 section. For purposes of s. 311.12, state seaports shall accept  
10 the criminal history and security threat assessment conducted on  
11 individuals holding a valid Transportation Worker Identification  
12 Credential card as sufficient to authorize unescorted access to  
13 a seaport or restricted access area. The department may set and  
14 collect a fee for entering a Transportation Worker  
15 Identification Credential cardholder into the Uniform Port
