20	to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:
21	320.08058 Specialty license plates
22	(65) FLORIDA TENNIS LICENSE PLATES
23	(a) The department shall develop a Florida Tennis license
24	plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear
25	at the top of the plate and the words "Play Tennis" must appear
26	at the bottom of the plate. The United States Tennis Association
27	Florida Section Foundation may submit a revised sample plate for
28	consideration by the department.
29	(b) The department shall distribute the annual use fees to
30	the Florida Sports Foundation, a direct-support organization of
31	the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development. The
32	license plate annual use fees shall be annually allocated as
33	follows:
34	1. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees
35	may be used by the Florida Sports Foundation to administer the
36	license plate program.
37	2. The United States Tennis Association Florida Section
38	shall receive the first \$60,000 in proceeds from the annual use
39	fees to reimburse it for startup costs, administrative costs, and
40	other costs it incurs in the development and approval process.
41	3. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees
42	may be used for promoting and marketing the license plates. The
43	remaining proceeds shall be available for grants by the United
44	States Tennis Association Florida Section Foundation to nonprofit
45	organizations to operate youth tennis programs and adaptive
46	tennis programs for special populations of all ages, and for
47	building, renovating, and maintaining public tennis courts.

52	(66) LIGHTHOUSE ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES
53	(a) The department shall develop a Lighthouse Association
54	license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
55	must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Visit Our
56	Lights" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
57	(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida
58	Lighthouse Association, Inc., which may use a maximum of 10
59	percent of the proceeds to promote and market the plates. The
60	remaining proceeds shall be used by the association to fund the
61	preservation, restoration, and protection of the 29 historic
62	lighthouses remaining in the state.
63	(67) I BELIEVE LICENSE PLATES
64	(a) The department shall develop an I Believe license plate
65	as provided in this section. However, the requirements of s.
66	320.08053 must be met before the plates are issued. The plate
67	must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The
68	word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate and the words
69	"I Believe" must appear at the bottom of the plate.
70	(b) The annual use fees from the plate shall be distributed
71	to Faith in Teaching, Inc., which may retain all revenue from the
72	use fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing
73	the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, Faith in Teaching,
74	Inc., shall allocate the annual use fees as follows:
75	1. A maximum of 10 percent may be used to offset
76	administrative costs incurred by Faith in Teaching, Inc.;

77	2. A maximum of 10 percent may be used to promote and
78	market the plate; and
79	3. The remaining funds shall be used to fund programs,
80	activities, and projects that promote faith-based education for
81	youth in this state.
82	(68) IN GOD WE TRUST LICENSE PLATES
83	(a) The department shall develop an In God We Trust license
84	plate as provided in this section. However, the requirements of
85	s. 320.08053 must be met before the plates are issued. In God We
86	Trust license plates must bear the colors and design approved by
87	the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
88	plate, and the words "In God We Trust" must appear in the body of
89	the plate.
90	(b) The license plate annual use fees shall be distributed
91	to the In God We Trust Foundation, Inc., to fund educational
92	scholarships for the children of Florida residents who are
93	members of the United States Armed Forces, the National Guard,
94	and the United States Armed Forces Reserve and for the children
95	of public safety employees who have died in the line of duty who
96	are not covered by existing state law. Funds shall also be
97	distributed to other 501(c)(3) organizations that may apply for
98	grants and scholarships and to provide educational grants to
99	public and private schools to promote the historical and
100	religious significance of American and Florida history. The In
101	God We Trust Foundation, Inc., shall distribute the license plate
102	annual use fees in the following manner:
103	1. The In God We Trust Foundation, Inc., shall retain all
104	revenues from the sale of such plates until all startup costs for
105	developing and establishing the plate have been recovered.



106	2. Ten percent of the funds received by the In God We Trust
107	Foundation, Inc., shall be expended for administrative costs,
108	promotion, and marketing of the license plate directly associated
109	with the operations of the In God We Trust Foundation, Inc.
110	3. All remaining funds shall be expended by the In God We
111	Trust Foundation, Inc., for programs.
