16 (65) FLORIDA TENNIS LICENSE PLATES.--

17        (a) The department shall develop a Florida Tennis license  
18 plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear  
19 at the top of the plate and the words "Play Tennis" must appear  
20 at the bottom of the plate. The United States Tennis Association  
21 Florida Section Foundation may submit a revised sample plate for  
22 consideration by the department.

23        (b) The department shall distribute the annual use fees to  
24 the Florida Sports Foundation, a direct-support organization of  
25 the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development. The  
26 license plate annual use fees shall be annually allocated as  
27 follows:

28            1. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees  
29 may be used by the Florida Sports Foundation to administer the  
30 license plate program.

31            2. The United States Tennis Association Florida Section  
32 shall receive the first \$60,000 in proceeds from the annual use  
33 fees to reimburse it for startup costs, administrative costs, and  
34 other costs it incurs in the development and approval process.

35            3. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees  
36 may be used for promoting and marketing the license plates. The  
37 remaining proceeds shall be available for grants by the United  
38 States Tennis Association Florida Section Foundation to nonprofit  
39 organizations to operate youth tennis programs and adaptive  
40 tennis programs for special populations of all ages, and for  
41 building, renovating, and maintaining public tennis courts.

42        (c) All grant recipients shall provide to the United States  
43 Tennis Association Florida Section Foundation an annual program  
44 and financial report regarding the use of grant funds. Such  
45 reports shall be made available to the public.

46        (66) LIGHTHOUSE ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES.--

47 (a) The department shall develop a Lighthouse Association  
48 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"  
49 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Visit Our  
50 Lights" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

51 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida  
52 Lighthouse Association, Inc., which may use a maximum of 10  
53 percent of the proceeds to promote and market the plates. The  
54 remaining proceeds shall be used by the association to fund the  
55 preservation, restoration, and protection of the 29 historic  
56 lighthouses remaining in the state.

57 (67) I BELIEVE LICENSE PLATES.--

58 (a) The department shall develop an I Believe license plate  
59 as provided in this section. However, the requirements of s.  
60 320.08053 must be met before the plates are issued. The plate  
61 must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The  
62 word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate and the words  
63 "I Believe" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

64 (b) The annual use fees from the plate shall be distributed  
65 to Faith in Teaching, Inc., which may retain all revenue from the  
66 use fees until all startup costs for developing and establishing  
67 the plate have been recovered. Thereafter, Faith in Teaching,  
68 Inc., shall allocate the annual use fees as follows:

69 1. A maximum of 10 percent may be used to offset  
70 administrative costs incurred by Faith in Teaching, Inc.;

71 2. A maximum of 10 percent may be used to promote and  
72 market the plate; and

73 3. The remaining funds shall be used to fund programs,  
74 activities, and projects that promote faith-based education for  
75 youth in this state.
