 2 Appropriations (Fasano) recommended the following **amendment:**

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

5 Delete everything after the enacting clause
6 and insert:

8 Section 1. Paragraphs (mmm) and (nnn) are added to
9 subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

10 320.08056 Specialty license plates.--

11 (4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be
12 collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

13 (mmm) Florida Tennis license plate, \$25.

14 (nnn) Lighthouse Association license plate, \$25.

15 Section 2. Subsections (65) and (66) are added to section
16 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

17 320.08058 Specialty license plates.--

18 (65) FLORIDA TENNIS LICENSE PLATES.--

19 (a) The department shall develop a Florida Tennis license
20 plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must appear
21 at the top of the plate and the words "Play Tennis" must appear
22 at the bottom of the plate. The United States Tennis Association
23 Florida Section Foundation may submit a revised sample plate for
24 consideration by the department.

25 (b) The department shall distribute the annual use fees to
26 the Florida Sports Foundation, a direct-support organization of
27 the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development. The
28 license plate annual use fees shall be annually allocated as
29 follows:

30 1. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees
31 may be used by the Florida Sports Foundation to administer the
32 license plate program.

33 2. The United States Tennis Association Florida Section
34 shall receive the first \$60,000 in proceeds from the annual use
35 fees to reimburse it for startup costs, administrative costs, and
36 other costs it incurs in the development and approval process.

37 3. Up to 5 percent of the proceeds from the annual use fees
38 may be used for promoting and marketing the license plates. The
39 remaining proceeds shall be available for grants by the United
40 States Tennis Association Florida Section Foundation to nonprofit
41 organizations to operate youth tennis programs and adaptive
42 tennis programs for special populations of all ages, and for
43 building, renovating, and maintaining public tennis courts.

44 (c) All grant recipients shall provide to the United States
45 Tennis Association Florida Section Foundation an annual program
46 and financial report regarding the use of grant funds. Such
47 reports shall be made available to the public.

48 (66) LIGHTHOUSE ASSOCIATION LICENSE PLATES.--

49 (a) The department shall develop a Lighthouse Association
50 license plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida"
51 must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Visit Our
52 Lights" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

53 (b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to the Florida
54 Lighthouse Association, Inc., which may use a maximum of 10
55 percent of the proceeds to promote and market the plates. The
56 remaining proceeds shall be used by the association to fund the
57 preservation, restoration, and protection of the 29 historic
58 lighthouses remaining in the state.

59 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
