An act relating to the possession of firearms; amending s. 933.14, F.S.; providing for a court order for the return of a confiscated firearm; providing criteria for determining if the firearm should be returned; providing

prohibitions on the return of the firearm; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 933.14, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

933.14 Return of property taken under search warrant.--

by <u>an</u> any officer with a search warrant, or without a search warrant upon a view by the officer of a breach of the peace, may not shall be returned except pursuant to <u>court</u> an order of a trial court judge. A person seeking the return of the firearm must file a sworn petition with the circuit court, which shall conduct a hearing on the matter. The court shall order the return of the firearm only upon evidence that the person does not pose a risk of harm to self or others and has the capacity to contract or manage his or her affairs. A firearm may not be returned to a person who is prohibited from purchasing a firearm under s.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
