Subsection (1) of section 45.035, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 45.035 Clerk's fees.--In addition to other fees or service charges authorized by law, the clerk shall receive service charges related to the judicial sales procedure set forth in ss. 45.031-45.034 and this section: (1) The clerk shall receive a service charge of \$60 for services in making, recording, and certifying the sale and title, which service charge shall be assessed as costs and shall be advanced by the plaintiff before the sale; however, if the sale is to be conducted by electronic means as authorized in s. <u>45.031(10), the fee shall be \$100</u>. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
