14	Section 1. Section 316.642, Florida Statutes, is created

17	(1) Each officer of a traffic enforcement agency, as
18	provided in s. 316.640(8), who stops an operator shall,
19	regardless of whether a traffic citation is issued or an arrest
20	is made as a result of the stop, record the name, address,
21	gender, and race of the operator and record whether the stop
22	involved a search and whether a citation was issued or an arrest
23	resulted. Each agency must maintain such information and forward
24	it to the Department of Transportation in a form and manner
25	determined by the department. The Department of Transportation
26	shall analyze the data and annually make a report to the
27	Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House
28	of Representatives, the Senate Minority Leader, and the House

The report must show separate statewide totals 30 for the state's county sheriffs and municipal law enforcement agencies, state law enforcement agencies, and state university 31 32 law enforcement agencies. 33 If the Governor determines that this data indicates (2) evidence of racial profiling by law enforcement officers, the 34 35 Governor shall appoint a task force reflective of Florida's 36 diverse population to review the data and recommend any 37 appropriate changes to traffic enforcement agency policies and 38 procedures or any other remedies. 39 The Department of Transportation has authority to (3) adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1) and 120.54 to implement 40 the provisions of this section conferring duties upon it. 41 42 Section 2. Subsection (9) of section 316.614, Florida 43 Statutes, is amended to read: 316.614 Safety belt usage.--44 By January 1, 2006, Each law enforcement agency in 45 (9) this state shall adopt departmental policies to prohibit the 46 47 practice of racial profiling. When a law enforcement officer issues a citation for a violation of this section, the law 48 49 enforcement officer must record the race and ethnicity of the 50 violator. All law enforcement agencies must maintain such 51 information and forward the information to the department in a form and manner determined by the department. The department 52 shall collect this information by jurisdiction and annually 53 report the data to the Governor, the President of the Senate, 54 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
