An act relating to licensure of psychologists; amending s. 490.005, F.S.; requiring the Board of Psychology to close application files of applicants failing to pass certain examinations, or failing to submit evidence of completion of postdoctoral supervised experience, within a specified timeframe; providing that an individual who completes the required postdoctoral training residency may continue to practice under supervision under certain conditions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 490.005, Florida Statutes, to read:

490.005 Licensure by examination. --

- (3) (a) The board shall close the application file of any applicant who fails to pass the psychology licensure examination and the laws and rules examination, or fails to submit evidence of completion of the postdoctoral supervised experience, within a timeframe specified by the board in rule.
- (b) An individual who completes the required postdoctoral training residency may continue to practice under supervision in a manner prescribed by the board by rule provided he or she has a current application on file and no final order of denial has been issued.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2009.
