| 10 | Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: |

| 12 | Section 1. Section 401.272, Florida Statutes, is amended |
| 13 | to read: |
| 14 | 401.272 Emergency medical services community health |
| 15 | care |
| 16 | (1) The purpose of this section is to encourage more |
| 17 | effective utilization of the skills of emergency medical |
| 18 | technicians and paramedics by enabling them to perform, in |
| 19 | partnership with local county health departments and licensed |
| 20 | hospitals, specific additional health care tasks that are |
| 21 | consistent with the public health and welfare. |
| 22 | (2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the |
| 23 | contrary: |
| 24 | (a) Paramedics or emergency medical technicians may |
| 25 | perform health promotion and wellness activities and blood |
| 26 | pressure screenings in a nonemergency environment, within the |
| 27 | scope of their training, and under the direction of a medical |
| 28 | director. As used in this paragraph, the term "health promotion |
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29 and wellness" means the provision of public health programs 30 pertaining to the prevention of illness and injury. Paramedics may administer immunizations in a 31 (b) 32 nonemergency environment, within the scope of their training, and under the direction of a medical director. There must be a 33 written agreement between the paramedic's medical director and 34 35 the county health department located in each county in which the 36 paramedic administers immunizations. This agreement must 37 establish the protocols, policies, and procedures under which the paramedic must operate. 38 Paramedics or emergency medical technicians may 39 (C) perform, in the emergency department of a licensed hospital, 40 activities permitted within the definition of basic life 41 42 support, regardless of whether the patient is experiencing a medical emergency. There must be a written agreement between the 43 44 paramedic's or the emergency medical technician's medical director and the hospital in which the paramedic or emergency 45 medical technician performs services. This agreement must 46 47 establish the protocols, policies, and procedures under which 48 the paramedic or emergency medical technician must operate. 49 Paramedics or emergency medical technicians may (d) 50 perform, in the emergency department of a licensed hospital, activities permitted within the definition of advanced life 51 52 support, regardless of whether the patient is experiencing a medical emergency. There must be a written agreement between the 53 54 paramedic's or the emergency medical technician's medical director and the hospital in which the paramedic or emergency 55 medical technician performs services. 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57 establish the protocols, policies, and procedures under which 58 the paramedic must operate.

Each medical director under whose direction a 59 (3) 60 paramedic administers immunizations, or under whose direction a 61 paramedic or emergency medical technician performs activities in 62 the emergency department of a licensed hospital, must verify and 63 document that the paramedic or emergency medical technician has received sufficient training and experience to perform such 64 65 activities administer immunizations. The verification must be documented on forms developed by the department, and the 66 67 completed forms must be maintained at the service location of the licensee and made available to the department upon request. 68

The department may adopt and enforce all rules (4)69 70 necessary to enforce the provisions relating to:

A paramedic's administration of immunizations and the 71 (a) 72 performance of health promotion and wellness activities and 73 blood pressure screenings by a paramedic or emergency medical 74 technician in a nonemergency environment.

75 (b) A paramedic's or emergency medical technician's 76 activities in the emergency department of a licensed hospital. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

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
