24	not obstruct sightlines at intersections and is not erected
25	within or upon an easement. The homeowner may further display in
26	a respectful manner from that flagpole, regardless of any
27	covenants, restrictions, bylaws, rules, or requirements of the
28	association, one official United States flag, not larger than 4
29	1/2 feet by 6 feet, and may additionally display one official
30	flag of the State of Florida or the United States Army, Navy,
31	Air Force, Marines, or Coast Guard, or a POW-MIA flag. Such
32	additional flag must be equal in size to or smaller than the
33	United States flag.
34	(c) This subsection applies to all community development
35	districts and homeowners' associations, regardless of whether
