House Resolution

A resolution recognizing March 11, 2008, as "Community Action Day" in Florida.

WHEREAS, community action agencies were created to fight the war on poverty when the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 was signed into law, and

WHEREAS, community action agencies comprise America's poverty-fighting network and have a 40-year history of promoting self-sufficiency for low-income families, children, and individuals, and

WHEREAS, there are over 1,000 community action agencies nationally, with 31 operational community action agencies serving low-income families, children, and individuals throughout 65 counties in this state, and

WHEREAS, in 2007, it was reported that the percentage of Americans living in poverty has reportedly reached a 32-year high, with millions of working Americans falling closer to the poverty line, and

WHEREAS, a recent analysis of the 2006 American Community Survey reported that over 38 million Americans are living below the poverty level and that Florida ranks 26th in states with the most people below the poverty level at 2,226,587, and

WHEREAS, Florida's community action agencies have made essential contributions to low-income families, children, and individuals by providing services to 363,604 individuals and 114,303 families in 2006, and

WHEREAS, Florida's community action agencies provide lowincome citizens with opportunities to improve their lives and their living conditions through innovative and cost-efficient programs, thus ensuring that all citizens are able to live in dignity, and

WHEREAS, as the war on poverty continues across the country, it is fitting to recognize and commend those community action agencies in this state that are at the forefront of this struggle, NOW THEREFORE,
