House Resolution

A resolution designating the month of January 2009 as "Cervical Cancer Awareness Month" in Florida.

5 WHEREAS, cervical cancer is the second most common cancer 6 diagnosed among women throughout the world, and

7 WHEREAS, Florida ranks fourth in the United States for the 8 highest number of new cervical cancer cases each year, and the 9 American Cancer Society estimates that 770 new cases will be 10 diagnosed in the state during 2008, and

WHEREAS, the primary cause of cervical cancer is infection with human papillomavirus (HPV), a virus commonly found in healthy women but that only rarely results in cancer, and

14 WHEREAS, early detection through annual Pap tests, as 15 recommended by the American Cancer Society, is the key to 16 detecting cervical cancer, and the incidence of and mortality 17 from cervical cancer has been greatly reduced as a result of 18 these tests, which can detect precancerous lesions that may be 19 treated before a cancer develops, and

20 WHEREAS, the incidence of cervical cancer can be 21 significantly reduced through the administration of the first 22 vaccine developed to prevent the infections that cause cervical 23 cancer to females between the ages of 9 and 26, and

24 WHEREAS, regular cervical cancer screening through programs 25 such as the Mary Brogan Breast and Cervical Cancer Early 26 Detection program funded by the Centers for Disease Control and 27 Prevention often results in early cervical cancer detection at 28 precancerous stages, NOW, THEREFORE,
