A resolution designating April 2008 as Swimming Pool Safety Month.

5 WHEREAS, the State of Florida has more than one million 6 swimming pools, over 37,000 of which are public facilities 7 regulated by the Department of Health, and

8 WHEREAS, residential and commercial swimming pools and spas 9 add to the enjoyment, quality of life, and health of our 10 citizens and visitors, and

11 WHEREAS, swimming pools and spas are recreational 12 facilities promoting the social gathering of families and 13 friends in a large percentage of Florida residences, and

14 WHEREAS, Florida hotels and condominiums have thousands of 15 swimming pools, spas, and wading pools used by even more 16 visitors and guests, and

WHEREAS, the education of building code and health department officials, swimming pool designers and contractors, and pool owners is paramount to ensuring pool safety, and

20 WHEREAS, the Virginia Graeme Baker Pool and Spa Safety Act 21 was recently signed into law by the President of the United 22 States, providing mandatory safety measures for public pool 23 facilities, incentive programs for residential pools, and 24 overall outreach and education on swimming pool safety, and

25 WHEREAS, a new national consensus safety standard,
26 ANSI/APSP 7 Suction Entrapment Avoidance, was developed by the
27 American National Standards Institute and adopted by the Florida

28 Building Commission, making the State of Florida a leader in 29 preventing serious injury from entrapment, and

30 WHEREAS, chapter 515, Florida Statutes, provides for the 31 Residential Swimming Pool Safety Act with a focus on backyard 32 pool safety and the prevention of drowning, and

33 WHEREAS, the Florida Swimming Pool Association (FSPA) and 34 the Florida Department of Health's Office of Injury Prevention 35 are co-hosting the 2008 Swimming Pool & Water Safety Forum to 36 increase safety awareness of consumers, pool industry 37 representatives, and government officials, and

38 WHEREAS, the Florida Swimming Pool Association continues to 39 promote safety messages to consumers and strives to educate the 40 pool industry on correct safety measures regarding barriers, 41 entrapment, and child supervision through classes, informative 42 brochures, and the new FSPA safety program, and

43 WHEREAS, swimming pool and spa injuries and accidents can 44 be prevented through the responsible behavior and preventive 45 actions of swimmers, owners, and those responsible for the 46 facilities, and

WHEREAS, the communication of swimming pool and spa safety
through the media during the peak period of use by consumers can
create increased safety awareness and promote the installation
and use of safety devices, NOW, THEREFORE,
