failure or refusal of one spouse to remove a barrier to the remarriage of the other spouse when considering the equitable distribution of marital assets and liabilities; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Present subsections (1) through (20) of section 61.046, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as subsections (2) through (21), respectively, and a new subsection (1) is added to that section, to read:
  - 61.046 Definitions.--As used in this chapter:
- (1) "Barrier to remarriage" means, without limitation and not exclusively, any religious, secular, or conscientious restraint or inhibition of which the spouse is aware, which is imposed on the other spouse, and which exists by reason of the spouse's commission or withholding of any voluntary act.
- Section 2. Present paragraph (j) of subsection (1) of section 61.075, Florida Statutes, is redesignated as paragraph (k), and a new paragraph (j) is added to that subsection, to read:
- 61.075 Equitable distribution of marital assets and liabilities.--
  - (1) In a proceeding for dissolution of marriage, in

addition to all other remedies available to a court to do equity between the parties, or in a proceeding for disposition of assets following a dissolution of marriage by a court which lacked jurisdiction over the absent spouse or lacked jurisdiction to dispose of the assets, the court shall set apart to each spouse that spouse's nonmarital assets and liabilities, and in distributing the marital assets and liabilities between the parties, the court must begin with the premise that the distribution should be equal, unless there is a justification for an unequal distribution based on all relevant factors, including:

(j) The failure or refusal of one spouse to remove a barrier to the remarriage of the other spouse.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
