Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section 316.191, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

316.191 Racing on highways.--

(1) As used in this section, the term:

(c) "Race" "Racing" means the use of one or more motor vehicles in competition, arising from a challenge to demonstrate superiority of a motor vehicle or driver and the acceptance or competitive response to that challenge, either through a prior arrangement or in immediate response, in which the competitor attempts an attempt to outgain or outdistance another motor vehicle, to prevent another motor vehicle from passing, to arrive at a given destination ahead of another motor vehicle or

17 motor vehicles, or to test the physical stamina or endurance of
18 drivers over long-distance driving routes. A race may be
19 prearranged or may occur through a competitive response to
20 conduct on the part of one or more drivers which, under the
21 totality of the circumstances, can reasonably be interpreted as
22 a challenge to race.
