WHEREAS, federal, state, and local governmental permit application, review, and approval policies and procedures remain a substantial complication to new reactor construction, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

That the Florida Legislature urges Congress to expedite the process for granting permits to develop and construct new nuclear power plants by authorizing a fast-track program that is open to new reactor applicants that meet specified criteria and conditions, that reduces the amount of time necessary to grant a permit for a new plant by half, and that does not sacrifice safety standards or security.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be dispatched to the President of the United States, to the President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the Florida delegation to the United States Congress.
