> A bill to be entitled An act relating to contracts; providing disclosure requirements for contracts for goods or services; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Disclosure of certain contract provisions.--
(1) All contracts for goods or services shall
conspicuously disclose the following:
(a) Any conditions placed upon the right to terminate the contract, including any provisions that provide for a right to cure.
(b) Any conditions or procedures relating to breach of contract or remedies for breach of contract, including any provisions related to arbitration.
(2) All disclosures of contract provisions under subsection (1) must be in bold type and placed within a separate paragraph.
(3) A contract containing provisions provided in subsection (1) shall provide, in immediate proximity to each of the provisions, a space reserved in the contract for the signature of all parties to specifically acknowledge having read each of such provisions. Failure to provide such spaces for signature and to obtain the signatures of all parties shall render the applicable contract provisions void and unenforceable.
