Section 2. Section 604.55, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

604.55 Structures at Florida State Farmers' Markets; exemption from building codes.—Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any structure on the grounds of a Florida State Farmers' Market is exempt from the Florida Building Code and any county or municipal building codes. For purposes of this
