Section 1. Section 255.043, Florida Statutes, is repealed.

Section 2. Notwithstanding the repeal by this act of s.

255.043, Florida Statutes, effective April 1, 2011, s. 255.043,

Florida Statutes, is reenacted, and the text of that section

shall revert to that in existence on June 30, 2009, except that

any amendments to such text enacted other than by this act shall

be preserved and continue to operate. In the interim, no

expenditures for public art under that section shall occur

without prior legislative approval.
