4 Between lines 2391 and 2392, insert:

5 Section 45. The Legislature finds that existing state
6 seaport security standards and measures are based upon a Florida
7 Seaport Security Assessment conducted in 2000, prior to the
8 development of federal and international layered seaport
9 security standards and measures. The Office of Drug Control
10 shall commission a critical seaport security review of state
11 standards and measures by a qualified vendor with expertise in
12 maritime security. The Office of Drug Control, the Florida
13 Department of Law Enforcement, and the Florida Seaport
14 Transportation and Economic Development Council shall mutually
15 select and approve the qualified vendor and mutually approve the
16 subject, scope, and performance of the review. The review shall

17 be presented to the Governor and the Legislature by January 1,
18 2010. Pursuant to s. 311.13, Florida Statutes, any records
