17	Section 1. Paragraphs (a) and (d) of subsection (1) of
18	section 101.657, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

20	(1)(a) As a convenience to the voter, the supervisor of
21	elections shall allow an elector to vote early in the main or
22	branch office of the supervisor. The supervisor shall mark,
23	code, indicate on, or otherwise track the voter's precinct for
24	each early voted ballot. <del>In order for a branch office to be used</del>
25	for early voting, it shall be a permanent facility of the
26	supervisor and shall have been designated and used as such for
27	<del>at least 1 year prior to the election.</del> The supervisor may also

29 <u>or any facility open to the public</u> as early voting sites; 30 however, if so designated, the sites must be geographically 31 located so as to provide all voters in the county an equal 32 opportunity to cast a ballot, insofar as is practicable. The 33 results or tabulation of votes cast during early voting may not 34 be made before the close of the polls on election day. Results 35 shall be reported by precinct.

36 Early voting shall begin on the 9th day before a (d) 37 primary election and on the 15th day before a general an 38 election and end on the 2nd day before an election. For purposes 39 of a special election held pursuant to s. 100.101, early voting shall begin on the 8th day before an election and end on the 2nd 40 41 day before an election. Early voting shall be provided for at 42 least 8 hours each day per weekday and 8 hours in the aggregate 43 each weekend at each site during the applicable periods. The 44 supervisor may allow early voting sites to remain open each day 45 for as long as the supervisor deems necessary. Early voting 46 sites shall open no sooner than 7 a.m. and close no later than 7 47 p.m. on each applicable day.
