## Senate Amendment to Amendment (947302) (with title amendment)

Between lines 1864 and 1865 insert:

Section 40. Effective July 1, 2010, all of the powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, and property; unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other funds; administrative authority; administrative rules; pending issues; and existing contracts of the Bureau of Onsite Sewage Programs in the Department of Health, as authorized and governed by ss. 20.43, 20.435, 153.73, 153.54, 163.3180, 180.03, 381.006,

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381.0061, 381.0064-381.0068, and 489.551-558, are transferred by a type II transfer, pursuant to s. 20.06(2), to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. In addition all existing powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, and property; unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, and other funds; administrative authority; administrative rules; pending issues; and existing contracts associated with county health departments' onsite sewage programs are transferred to the Department of Environmental Protection. The Department of Environmental Protection in cooperation with the Department of Health must develop a plan to implement the type II transfer and deliver the proposal to the Governor, the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by January 15, 2010.
