Between lines 2634 and 2635, insert:

Section 22. By February 1, 2010, the Office of Program Policy Analysis and Government Accountability shall submit a report to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate, the Commissioner of Insurance, the Chief Financial Officer, and the Governor reviewing the laws governing public adjusters as defined in s. 626.854, Florida Statutes. The report shall include a review of relevant Citizens Property Insurance Corporation claims and statistics involving public adjusters, public adjuster claims submission practices, and a review of the laws of this state and rules governing public adjusters. The report shall also review state laws governing public adjusters throughout the United States.

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17 The review shall encompass a review of both catastrophe and
18 noncatastrophe related claims, with a specific focus on new and
19 supplemental or reopened catastrophe claims originated in 2009
20 which relate to hurricanes that occurred in 2004 and 2005. The
21 study shall review the effects on consumers of the laws of this
22 state relating to public adjusters.
