Subsections (3), (4), and (5) of section 15 1003.455, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 16 1003.455 Physical education; assessment.--17 (3)Each district school board shall provide 150 minutes of physical education each week for students in kindergarten 18 19 through grade 5 and for students in grade 6 who attend schools 20 that operate in self-contained classes on an elementary school 21 schedule are enrolled in a school that contains one or more 22 elementary grades so that on any day during which physical 23 education instruction is conducted there are at least 30 24 consecutive minutes per day. Beginning with the 2009-2010 school year, the 25 (4) 26 equivalent of one class period per day of physical education for 27 one semester of each year is required for students enrolled in 28 grades 6 through 8. Students enrolled in such instruction shall Page 1 of 2

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29 be reported through the periodic student membership surveys, and 30 records of such enrollment shall be audited pursuant to s. 31 1010.305. Such instruction may be provided by any instructional 32 personnel as defined in s. 1012.01(2), regardless of 33 certification, who are designated by the school principal.

34 (5) (4) The requirement in subsection (4) (3) shall be 35 waived for a student who meets one of the following criteria:

36 (a) The student is enrolled or required to enroll in a
37 remedial course or is not meeting grade-level expectations in
38 reading, writing, mathematics, or science.

39 (b) The student's parent indicates in writing to the 40 school that:

41 1. the parent requests that the student enroll in another 42 course from among those courses offered as options by the school 43 district.; or

44 <u>(c)</u><sup>2</sup>. <u>The student's parent indicates in writing and</u> 45 <u>provides documentation to the school that</u> the student is 46 participating in physical activities outside the school day 47 which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement.

48 <u>(6) (5)</u> Each school district shall notify the student's 49 parent of the options available under subsection <u>(5)</u> (4) before 50 scheduling the student to participate in physical education.

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Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009.

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
