19 473.305 Fees.--The board, by rule, may establish fees to 20 be paid for applications, examination, reexamination, licensing 21 and renewal, reinstatement, and recordmaking and recordkeeping. 22 The fee for the examination shall be established at an amount 23 that covers the costs for the procurement or development, 24 administration, grading, and review of the examination. The fee 25 for the examination is refundable if the applicant is found to be ineligible to sit for the examination. The fee for initial 26 27 application is nonrefundable, and the combined fees for 28 application and examination may not exceed \$250 plus the actual 29 per applicant cost to the department for purchase of the examination from the American Institute of Certified Public 30 31 Accountants or a similar national organization. The biennial renewal fee may not exceed \$250. The board may also establish, 32 33 by rule, a reactivation fee, a late filing fee for the law and 34 rules examination, and a delinquency fee not to exceed \$50 for 35 continuing professional education reporting forms. The board 36 shall establish fees which are adequate to ensure the continued operation of the board and to fund the proportionate expenses 37 38 incurred by the department which are allocated to the regulation 39 of public accountants.
