22	(e) Every proposed comprehensive plan amendment package

24	163.3184(3) shall be accompanied by a \$5,000 fee. Every proposed
25	comprehensive plan amendment package transmitted to the state
26	land planning agency pursuant to s. 163.32465(4) shall be

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27	accompanied by a \$6,500 fee. A proposed package containing one
28	or more amendments subject to review under s. 163.3184(3) and
29	one or more amendments subject to review under s. 163.32465(4)
30	shall be accompanied by a fee of \$6,500. Every adopted
31	comprehensive plan amendment transmitted to the state land
32	planning agency pursuant to s. 163.3177(3(b)2. shall be
33	accompanied by a fee of \$1,250. The state land planning agency
34	shall deposit all fees collected into the Operating Trust Fund
