A bill to be entitled

An act relating to a review under the Open Government
Sunset Review Act; amending s. 119.071, F.S., relating
to an exemption from public-records requirements for
information that would identify or locate a child who
participates in a government-sponsored recreation
program or a parent or guardian of the child;
providing definitions; reorganizing the exemption and
making editorial changes; saving the exemption from
repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act;
repealing s. 2, ch. 2004-32, Laws of Florida, which
provides for repeal of the exemption; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section
119.071, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

119.071 General exemptions from inspection or copying of
public records.—

(5) OTHER PERSONAL INFORMATION.—

(c) 1. For purposes of this paragraph, the term:

a. "Child" means any person younger than 18 years of age.

b. "Government-sponsored recreation program" means a
program for which an agency assumes responsibility for a child
participating in that program, including, but not limited to,
after-school programs, athletic programs, nature programs,

28 summer camps, or other recreational programs.

29 2. Any Information that would identify or help to locate a
30 child who participates in a government-sponsored recreation
31 program programs or camps or the parents or guardians of such
32 child, including, but not limited to, the name, home address,
33 telephone number, social security number, or photograph of the
34 child; the names and locations of schools attended by such
35 child; and the names, home addresses, and social security
36 numbers of parents or guardians of such child is exempt from s.
37 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.
38 Information made exempt pursuant to this paragraph may be
39 disclosed by court order upon a showing of good cause.

40 3. Information that would identify or locate a parent or
41 guardian of a child who participates in a government-sponsored
42 recreation program is exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a),
43 Art. I of the State Constitution.

44 4. This exemption applies to records held before, on, or
45 after the effective date of this exemption.

46 Section 2. Section 2 of chapter 2004-32, Laws of Florida,
47 is repealed.

48 Section 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
