17 Section 1. Section 1004.4472, Florida Statutes, is amended
18 to read:

22 (1) For purposes of this section, the term:

23 (a) "Corporation" means the Florida Institute for Human and
24 Machine Cognition, Inc.

25 (b) "Subsidiary" means a subsidiary authorized and approved
26 by the corporation.

32 (a) Material relating to methods of manufacture or
33 production, potential trade secrets, patentable material, actual

36 during the course of research conducted by or through the
37 corporation or a subsidiary Florida Institute for Human and

40 (b) Any information received by the corporation or a
41 subsidiary from a person from another state or nation or the
42 Federal Government which is otherwise exempt or confidential
43 pursuant to the laws of that state or nation or pursuant to
44 federal law.

45 (c) Any information received by the corporation or a
46 subsidiary in the performance of its duties and responsibilities
47 which is otherwise confidential and exempt by law.

48 (d) All identifying information of a donor or prospective
49 donor to the corporation or a subsidiary who wishes to remain
50 anonymous.

51 (3)~~(2)~~ The corporation or its subsidiary shall permit any
52 governmental entity to inspect or copy confidential and exempt
53 information held by the corporation or its subsidiary which is
54 necessary for that governmental entity to perform its duties and
55 responsibilities. ~~Any governmental entity that is permitted to~~
56 ~~inspect or copy confidential and exempt information held by the~~
57 ~~corporation or a subsidiary shall maintain the confidential and~~
