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The Policy and Steering Committee on Ways and Means (Justice) recommended the following:

## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

Between lines 1692 and 1693 insert:

Section 7. Subsection (2) of section 627.711, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (3) is added to that section, to read:

627.711 Notice of premium discounts for hurricane loss mitigation; uniform mitigation verification inspection form.—

(2) (a) By July 1, 2007, the Financial Services Commission shall develop by rule a uniform mitigation verification inspection form that shall be used by all insurers when



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submitted by policyholders for the purpose of factoring discounts for wind insurance. In developing the form, the commission shall seek input from insurance, construction, and building code representatives. Further, the commission shall provide guidance as to the length of time the inspection results are valid. An insurer shall accept as valid a uniform mitigation verification form certified by the Department of Financial Services or signed by:

- (a) A hurricane mitigation inspector employed by approved My Safe Florida Home wind certification entity;
  - (b) A building code inspector certified under s. 468.607;
- (c) A general or residential contractor licensed under s. 489.111;
- (d) A professional engineer licensed under s. 471.015 who has passed the appropriate equivalency test of the Building Code Training Program as required by s. 553.841; or
  - (e) A professional architect licensed under s. 481.213.
- (3) An individual or entity who knowingly provides or utters a false or fraudulent mitigation verification form with the intent to obtain or receive a discount on an insurance premium to which the individual or entity is not entitled commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.
